The park is less than 100 acres, so you don't need much time for walking the grounds. With that said, the Arch is an extremely fun photography subject, so, if you like taking pictures, spend some time with it in different light/sky. Interest in museums varies from person-to-person, but the main museum is modern and engaging. The Old Courthouse was closed for renovations,

including a new museum, when I typed this. It wasn't all that impressive when I went through last, but I did enjoy the Dred Scott exhibit.

<u>tours</u> to choose from.

Maybe stick around the city to catch a sporting event or explore its parks?

Need to Know

- Oddly, it is called a "timed-entry" park. But you can tour the museum and grounds any time and often can get same-day tram tickets.
- So, <u>reservations</u> are a good idea. It does get busy in summer, especially for the 4th.
- Parking can be difficult to find.
 There are a few garages on 4th
 Street and other paid parking lots nearby. Or park at the casino on the other side of the river and walk on over.


