

### **How Much Time?**

Each unit is relatively small, with short scenic drives. It's easy to drive them and stop at a few viewpoints in a day. It's definitely worth sticking around for sunrise/sunset. Saguaro make excellent silhouettes! If you like hiking and/or backpacking, stick around longer. Hiking up to Wasson Peak (multiple routes, I like Hugh Norris) in the West Unit and backpacking to Manning Camp in the East Unit are worthwhile endeavors. It gets cold (and occasionally snows) at Manning Camp, so be prepared for it.

### **Need to Know**

- Each unit is open roughly from sunrise to sunset.
- Saguaro don't bloom until June.
- Be prepared for the heat. It can be hot any day of the year.
- Backpackers headed to Manning Camp must be prepared for the cold. Things are a little different around 8,000 feet!
