Need to Know

- Trunk Bay is the one spot plastered on all the St. John marketing materials. It's sublime. It also has a nominal entrance fee. The only one in the park.
- To get here, most visitors fly into St. Thomas and then ferry (or water taxi) to St. John (where the park is).
- Ferries arrive at Cruz Bay (St. John) from Red Hook and Charlotte Amalie (on St. Thomas).
- You don't need a car rental, but it will simplify travel. Most car rental companies will wait for you at the dock.
